Summary

The comedy begins when married couple Domina and Senex go on a trip to visit Domina's mother. Their son Hero is left in the care of Pseudolus, an ever mischievous slave who only wants his freedom. While his parents are away, Hero falls in love with a woman (Philia) he sees in the neighboring window. A few major problems with this match are that the girl is owned by Lycus, a buyer and seller of courtesans, and Hero's parents would more than disapprove. Pseudolus's only responsibility is to protect Hero's innocence, but that is thrown into jeopardy when Hero offers freedom to Pseudolus in exchange for Philia. This all seems to be a simple trade if it weren't for yet another major problem: Philia has already been purchased by another and her time left in the house of Lycus is running out. Pseudolus, desperate for his freedom, will do just about anything in order to make things work. A variety of plans, tricks, lies, and comedy ensue as all the characters attempt to make their dreams come true.

Dramaturgy

The 1963 Tony award-winning musical, *A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum*, takes credit from the comedians of Ancient Rome.

Forum is compiled of Plautus's plays *Pseudolus*, *Casina*, and *Miles Gloriosus*. Elements that made these plays popular in Ancient Rome remain prominent in *Forum*. Plautus's stock characters such as the clever slave, the young lovers, the lecherous old man and the arrogant captain are not only seen in *Forum* but have been used in countless productions in many cultures.

Larry Gelbart, Burt Shevelove (authors known by TV's M*A*S*H fans) and Stephen Sondheim broke the mold of traditional musical theatre by having only one stage set and almost no costume changes. Using Plautus's characters and incidents, the team wove a new plot with new subplots and situations. The excitement of *Forum* begins as soon as the audience sits down. The play is constantly in motion as the characters zoom from one zany situation to the next. The wonderful songs of Stephen Sondheim contribute to the merriment.

Forum ran for 964 performances (Sondheim's longest running show), proving that the world's oldest jokes can still delight and amuse audiences more than 2000 years later. Our production of *A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum* promises to be an exhibition of gags, puns, and, of course, comedy - something for "everybawdy."
