The goal of this tournament is to feature some of the best teams in the state of Illinois and create a postseason-type atmosphere.


The tournament field features four outstanding teams: Joliet Township, Highland, Chatham Glenwood and host Edwardsville.



John Hackett batted .333 for the Tigers last season in limited duty. This year Hackett has picked up the majority of the catching assignments for Edwardsville lately.



Recap of the First Annual Intelligencer/Tiger Classic

Last season, the First Annual Intelligencer/Tiger Classic kicked off with a bang. Or better yet, a swirl. Opening day of the tournament was called soon after it was scheduled to begin when a tornado — visible from the EHS Sports Comlex — hit the area.

A shortened version of the tournament was finally played on Saturday, with Edwardsville High knocking off Highland in the championship game to claim the tournament's first-ever title. Only three teams played with Highland and Edwardsville each beating Chatham Glenwood to advance to the championship game.

But it wasn't an easy road for the Tigers.

Edwardsville had to come from behind twice to knock off the previously unbeaten Titans to advance to the championship game. Against Chatham, Tiger starter Gregg Culp battled Titan ace Kevin Hall pitch for pitch through four innings, each allowing two hits and two runs before being lifted. Chatham would take a 3-2 lead in the fifth, and it would remain that way until the bottom of the seventh inning when EHS tied it at 3-3, forcing extra innings.

Chatham would regain the lead with two runs in the eighth inning. But once again, Edwardsville came back, plating a pair of runs to make it 5-5. The Tigers finally finished off the Titans in the ninth when Zach Frey coaxed a walk and stole second base before Ted Messer delivered the game-winning single for the 6-5

victory.

Then, in the title tilt, Edwardsville oped up a 6-0 lead early against the Bulldogs. But Highland kept battling, cutting the lead to 7-6 in the third inning on a grand slam by Jake Odorizzi. But Edwardsville held off the

Bulldogs late to claim the title, 8-6.

Odorizzi was named the tournament's Most Valuable Pitcher after dominating the Titans, allowing just three hits in a 2-0 shutout victory. He fanned 10 along the way. Edwardsville's Todd Baumgartner, now playing at Arkansas State, was named the tournament's Most Valuable Player after collecting three hits against Chatham and singling, walking and scoring a run against Highland. Highland's Brian Carney was named the tournament's Most Valuable Defensive Player.




