Biographical Summary of Jack E. Vizer By Rance Olliges

Jack E. Vizer was born on October 3, 1928 in a house on Olive Street in the Lincoln Place neighborhood of Granite City, Illinois. He was the third born son of his parents, and he has two sons of his own. Jack's grandfather came to America from Hungary sometime in the early 1900s, about 1906 he thinks. Jack's father worked at the Commonwealth Plant in Granite City. Jack claims his father loved the United States, but he hated income tax.
